2. Fill in and submit completed enrolment form.

Criteria to Participate

- Struggle in traditional academic settings and/or exams
- Do well on the job but not on testing
- May have a disability
- May have a skill gap
- Have few resources for support

What you need to Participate

- Reliable internet connection
- Availability to meet with a learning strategist

An iPad (with learning apps installed), headphones, otterbox case and keyboard will be on loan to student after registration.
